We need your help!

Census Day Thursday, 1st October 2020

Are you one of the 50 families in Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and Free School Meals who have not ordered a meal for Thursday, 1st October?

The funding we receive for school meals is based on the average uptake from two core dates in the academic year; Thursday, 1st October 2020 and Thursday, 21st January 2021. It is vital that we maximise every opportunity to have a full uptake on these two days. The funding is intended to cover the full cost of the provision; any deficit would need to be found from school block funding which could potentially affect the provision a school could offer for the children's education.

To help with the uptake on this day ham or cheese baguette pizza with curly fries and a snack bag have been added to the menu. The current options are still available on this day, however if you have already ordered your child's meal you can change their lunch order up to the evening of Wednesday, 30th September.

Parents/carers can really help us ring-fence our school budget by ordering a meal on this day. Please do all you can to support us.

Hot Food Menu

Unfortunately, the hot meal menu remains suspended and will be re-instated as soon as practically possible. The children are currently eating in their classroom spaces and hot food odours tend to 'linger' which can have an impact on a learning environment. All updates will be communicated via email.
