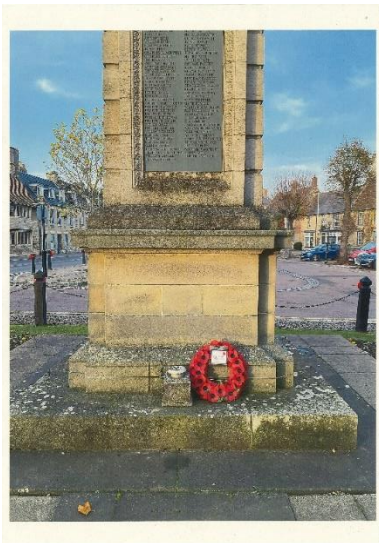

Vehicles

Whilst the vast majority of parents drive responsibly when bringing pupils to or collecting them from school, we have received a number of complaints from local residents with regard to inappropriate driving behaviour and in some cases discourteous interactions with them. The safety of pupils and local residents is potentially being put at risk.

Examples of which we have been notified include:

- Blocking drives and roadways
- Causing gridlock through inconsiderate parking or waiting in the middle of a road
- Turning dangerously – either reversing into private drives or carrying out U-turns
- When challenged, drivers being rude to local residents
- Speeding

We understand why there is an increased in parental transport, however please consider the impact you have on those who live locally if you drive pupils to school. Therefore, please can we ask that:

- Always consider if you need to drive to school; can you walk or park and stride?
- Consider the impact of your driving and parking on our neighbours
- Consider where you are waiting

There are instances of parents/carers arriving 45 minutes prior to collection, please consider walking to collect your child/ren where possible.

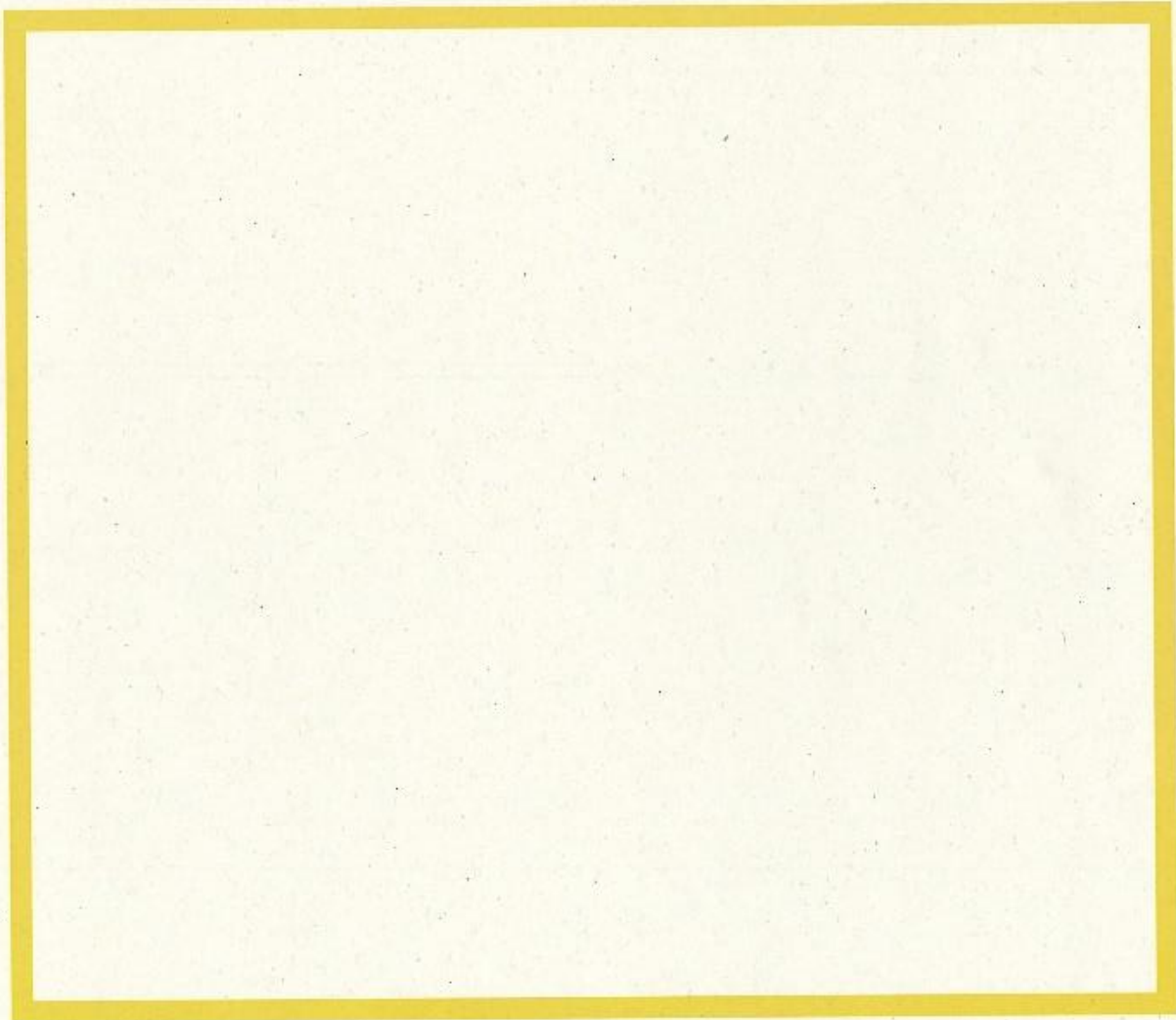
