

# Uniform Reminder...

Please be reminded of the school uniform policy which can be read in full on our [website](#).

We would like to particularly highlight the importance of children coming to school prepared for the weather and wear coats if cold and sun protection (in the form of hats and sun cream) when needed. # School Day Timings

We are noticing an increase in the number of children arriving at school before their scheduled times. This has a negative impact on the car parking availability outside of school.

As you are aware, only children with siblings who are due to arrive earlier than them are permitted to arrive earlier than their allocated time for their year group. **Everybody else must arrive at the time stated.**

By ensuring that you and your child arrive on time and not before eases congestion and increases the likelihood of parking spaces being available outside of school both at drop off and collection.
