












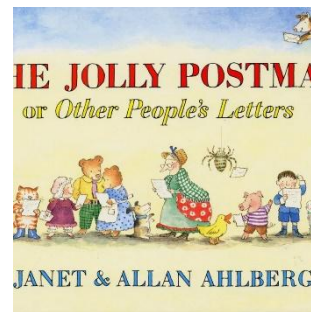
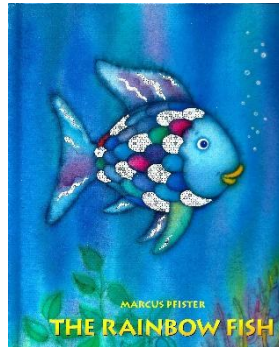
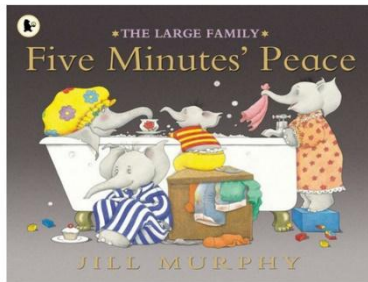


# KS1 Curriculum Newsletter

## Term 3 2025 - 2026

<p>As writers we will learn to write a non-chronological report based on Emperor Penguins. We will be learning about different sentence types- statement, command, exclamation and question.</p> 	<p>As mathematicians we will be learning about shapes focusing on sides, edges, vertices and faces. We will also be learning how to add and subtract 10's as well as adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers.</p> 	<p>As scientists we will be learning about the properties of different materials. We will learn the difference between man-made and natural resources as well as what materials are used for.</p> 
<p>As historians we will learn about the Plantagenets. We will learn about life inside a Plantagenet castle, the roles people had and who was the most important.</p> 	<p>As geographers we will be developing spatial sense in and around the school setting and the local area. We will learn about a bird's eye view and the features of a simple sketch map.</p> 	<p>In PSHE we will focus on keeping safe. We will learn about medicines and safe and unsafe situations. We will be discussing who pupils can talk to if they ever feel unsafe.</p> 
<p>As artists we will be learning about shape and texture. We will be exploring the styles of the famous artists Wassily Kandinsky, Henri Matisse and Maurice Sendak. We will be mixing colours, exploring how lines create texture and cutting out shapes to create a collage.</p> 	<p>As musicians we will be listening, singing, playing, improvising and composing. We will be learning about inventing a musical story and exploring how music makes the world a better place.</p> 	<p>As athletes we will be learning about team building and invasion games.</p> 
<p>As technicians we will be creating art in the style of Piet Mondrian's work. We will also be introduced to spreadsheets. We will learn how to enter data into cells and use basic tools to add colour to cells, add and remove rows and complete simple maths calculations.</p> 	<p>As theologists will be learning about Judaism. We will learn about the story of creation and about the festival of Shabbat and why it's important.</p> 	<p>In phonics, we will be learning to read unfamiliar words containing the new sounds taught in phonics lessons.</p>
