












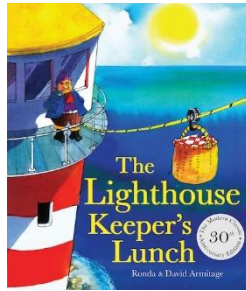
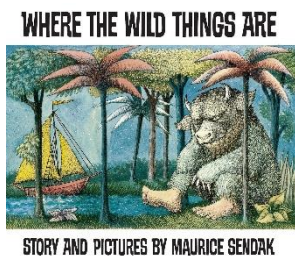


Key Stage 1 Curriculum Newsletter

Term 4 2025 - 2026

<p>As writers we will learn how to write a journey story based on the Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch. We will learn about using adjectives and expanded noun phrases to describe the animals in our story.</p> 	<p>As mathematicians we will continue to develop our understanding of multiplication and division. This term we will explore counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will recognise, make and add equal groups and begin to learn facts for our 2, 5 and 10 times tables.</p> 	<p>As scientists we will learn about a range of plants and their parts. We will learn about seed dispersal and what a plant needs to grow. We will conduct our own experiment by planting seeds in different conditions to test how well they grow.</p> 
<p> As historians we will focus on Medieval Britain. We will learn about the Black Death. We will explore symptoms and believed cures of the plague and learn about how people were affected by it.</p>	<p>As geographers we will learn about climate. We will explore the difference between weather and climate and how this is different around the world. We will learn about the 3 major climate zones and explore different ways of measuring weather.</p> 	<p>In PSHE we will focus on 'rights and respect'. We will learn about getting on with others, focusing on helping, sharing, taking turns and listening.</p> 
<p>As artists we will be exploring Medieval Art. We will explore Traditional Western Calligraphy, illuminated manuscripts and relief carvings. We will learn how to print using stamps, polystyrene and ink.</p> 	<p>As musicians we will be recognising different sounds. We will be exploring how music teaches us about our neighbourhood through singing, listening, playing, improvising and composing.</p> 	<p>As athletes we will be exploring target games, net and wall games and multi-skills within an indoor space.</p> 
<p> As technicians we will be creating digital books and learning how to work with images, text and sound. They will learn how to animate simple objects.</p>	<p>As theologians we will be learning about why our world is special, how to look after it and understanding that people have different beliefs about how the world began.</p> 	<p>In phonics, we will be learning to read unfamiliar words containing the new sounds taught in phonics lessons.</p>
